DIAZ CONTEMPORARY

Reaching the Gallery via Public Transit (TTC)

There are many ways to reach the Diaz Contemporary by TTC. Here is one basic route:

From Bloor and Yonge subway station, take the Yonge/University subway line southbound to either King or St. Andrew station (both of these stations are on King Street).

Exit the subway, and take the King streetcar westbound (make sure to take a transfer when you get on the subway—you'll need it for the streetcar.)

Ask the driver to let you off at Tecumseth St. (pronounced tuh-cum-say), just West of Bathurst Street.

Cross King Street to the south side, and continue walking down Tecumseth until you get to Niagara Street (a few blocks.)

Diaz Contemporary sits on the northeast corner of the intersection, with the gallery's main entrance being at 100 Niagara Street.
